


Electric Bicycle Discussion

Florida Statutes & City Ordinance

- 2020: F.S. 316.003 ELECTRIC BICYCLE defined
- 2020: F.S. 316.20655 Electric bicycle regulations
 - Afforded rights to electric bicycle users
- 2021: Ord. 21-12 Article IX: "Electric Bicycle, Motorized Scooters and Micromobility Devices"
 - Restricted ebike operation on sidewalks
 - Set 15MPH limit in specific areas

Usage

- Most electric bicycle devices are owned by the user.
- 2022: Approximately 1,000 daily bicycle trips along the Florida Keys Overseas Heritage
 Trail near Home Depot




Education

- 2022: Bus Stop Electronic Signage
 - North Roosevelt Blvd
 - Palm Ave



Education

- Literature always available Online, City Hall, and the Key West Library
 - Available in Spanish and Haitian Creole
- Outreach Events
 - Local markets, Childrens' Day, on the Promenade, etc.



Education

- 2023: Electric Bicycle, Motorized Scooter, and Micromobility Workshop
- 2023: Pavement Markings
 - 2 Locations along Atlantic Blvd
- Social Media assets
 - Facebook & Instagram reach 9K/mo



Electric Bicycle Regulations

- No age requirement
- Helmet required for riders under 16 years of age. F.S. 316.2065(3)(d)
- No license or insurance requirements. F.S. 316.20655(2)
- Label displaying classification, top assisted speed, and motor wattage. *F.S.* 316.20655(3)



Electric Bicycle Definition


- Electric motor of less than 750 watts. F.S. 316.003(23)
- Meet specific requirements of Class 1, 2, or 3. F.S. 316.003(23)
- Top assisted speed of 28MPH. F.S. 316.003(23)(c)




